Every Presbyterian shares in the benefit of the PC(USA)'s system of government, so every Presbyterian is asked to share the expenses associated with coordinating and performing the functions of that system.

Per Capita is a fundamental way in which all of the nearly 9,000 congregations and governing bodies of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) are connected and participate in the work of the wider church. The money is distributed to the three entities to which FPC belongs in the higher levels of our church government: the Presbytery of Wyoming, the Synod of the Rocky Mountains and to the National General Assembly. These three entities use the money for the ministries that they do on behalf of our church. A sample of those ministries is listed on the back of this sheet.
